












Complete Action Examples



Action E3 - Progress the Phase 3 development activities related to Mersey Tidal and commence Phase 4 activity to Consent a UK first of a kind (FOAK) Tidal range scheme.

 Decision to commence Phase 4 Development Consenting activity and intent to progress to Scoping Decision with Planning Inspectorate approved at CA meeting on 15 Mar 2024.

Action E4 / IN2 - Complete delivery of LCR's Green Hydrogen Vision Study to assess transition from fossil fuels.

GHVS study completed at end of 2023 and shared with colleagues in LA teams.

Action B4 - Deliver the decarbonisation plans for the first 50 public buildings to get ready to bid for Public Sector Decarbonisation Scheme funding.

 The North West Net Zero Hub has used £384,000 of Low Carbon Skills Fund money to assess 52 public buildings, to see what measures are needed to get them to net zero. This work forms the decarbonisation plans and informs the cost required to achieve net zero.





Delayed Action Example

Action CC12 - Regularly review energy consumption and demand forecasts for each pillar to inform the Liverpool City Region policy setting and action planning.

- This was an action from Nov 2022 NZDB on sectors to provide a demand forecast for 2023-28
- This is an action deemed to be behind where the SRO believes it needs to be
- This action is a short-term action that the Combined Authority is leading



Actions in Progress Examples



Action T4 - Explore the potential of a City Region wide Electric Vehicle fuelling strategy and infrastructure delivery plan, linked to funding opportunities available through LEVI (local electric vehicle infrastructure) funding in 2023/24 and 2024/25.

- LEVI Grant funding received (£8m 90%) in March 2024 following Stage 2 submission
- Final scope being generated with LA teams
- Project team to be appointed (interviews June 2024)

Action B5 - Identify forthcoming government grant funding opportunities and work to attract all appropriate government grants, maximising delivery opportunities for the Liverpool City Region.

• Public Sector Decarbonisation Scheme grant approved for £5.4m in May 2024. Application for Low Carbon Skills Fund 5 submitted in April 2024.

Action CC4 - Roll out carbon literacy training across the Combined Authority and enable more people and businesses to access such training to understand their current climate impact and potential actions.

- 59 Combined Authority employees have been issued with carbon literacy certification following training
- 2 Combined Authority carbon literate staff members have been trained to deliver training to fellow staff
- 5 more dates to deliver training sessions are on the Learning Portal
